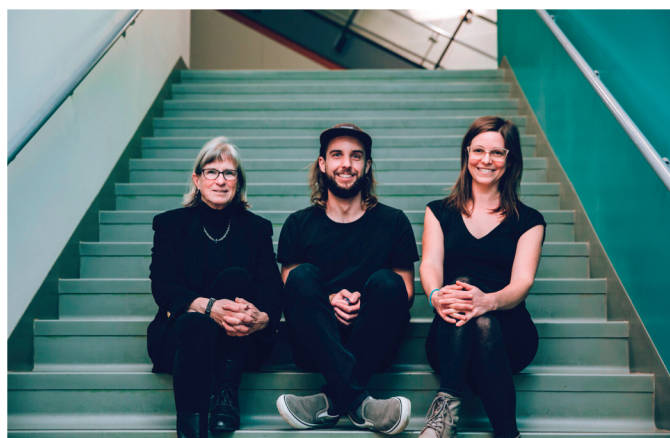


Director: Céline Sciamma | Rating: PG | French with Subtitles
